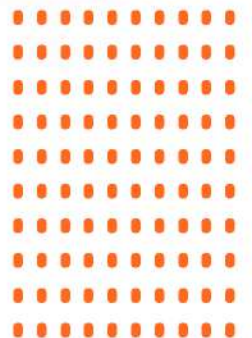

HuYaMwi works with 65 Parishes. 64 Parishes in Northern Diocese and 1 Parish in Meru Diocese providing services to Orphans, widows and sick People.

This year 2022 HuYaMwi serves over 72 orphans in scholarship program pursued college studies, 780 orphans in secondary school and Vocational Training Centres. We also support needy people with medical services where 550 clients got health insurances. Other programs includes building houses and materials support to orphans and widows.

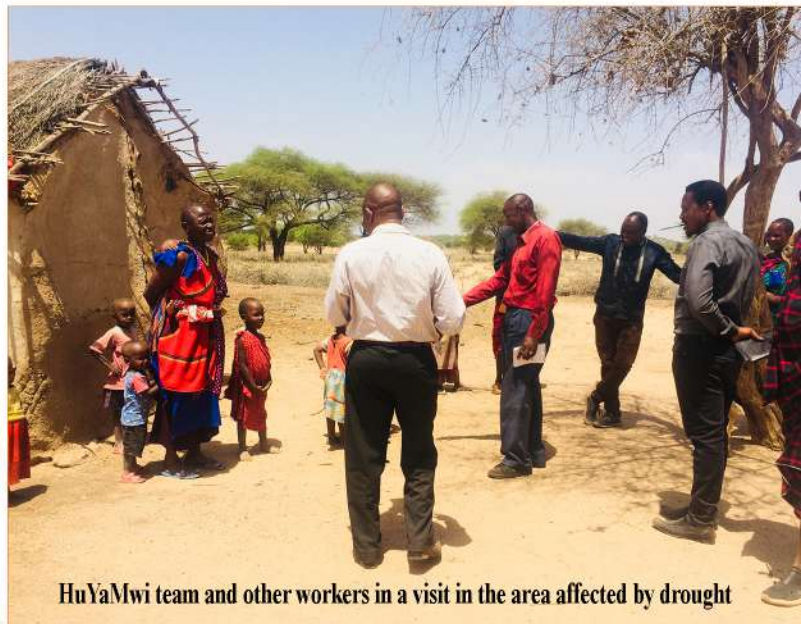


In this year 2022, Huyamwi has organized a seminar for church leaders, which aimed to build their capacity to serve the needy in their parish level

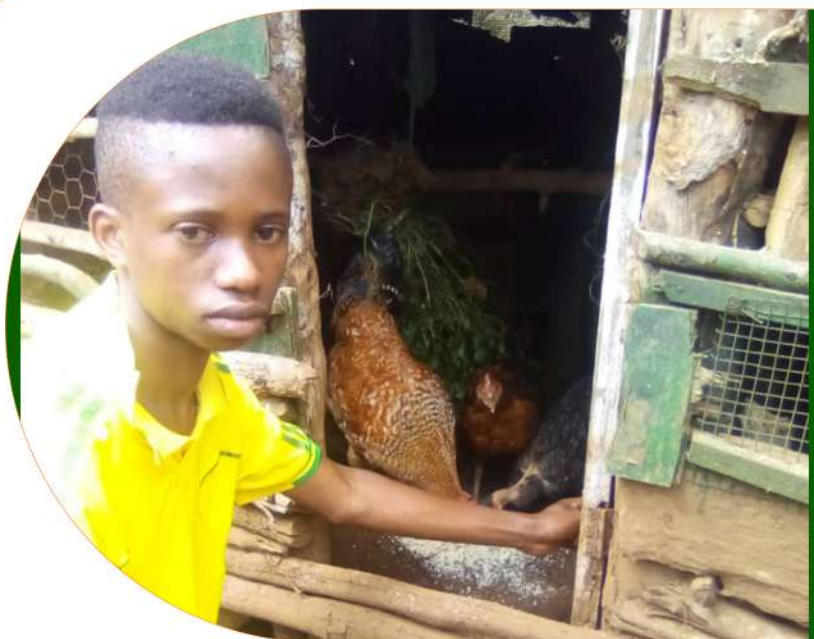

# SHOLORSHIP PROGRAM IN A POOL SYSTEM AND HEALTH INSURANCE

Pool System, This is a special system under scholarship program that helps orphans who are in secondary schools. This system has been working for HuYaMwi contributes half of the school fee, and the other half is contributed by the guardians along with the Parishes. This system has been very successful as we have been able to educate 780 orphans this year .



Health insurance is one of HuYaMwi's program for the needy. This has been a great blessing because when they get sick and lack money for treatment, they are very upset. But the insurance has brought a great relief to 550 families as they can be treated when they are sick.

# Building Support

Ndeenengo makyangoo is an old woman who lives with her grandchildren. Their parents died a long time ago. This old woman had a big challenge of the place to live. Her house was broken, situation that was dangerous to lives. A group of youth in Kisamo Parish started to build her house then asked HuYaMwi to participate. This initiatives was very attractive.
